Navoi's legacy can increase the desire of high school students to overcome ignorance through enlightenment.

In the epic "Layli and Majnun" the poet writes:

Insongʻa erur kamol matlub, Andin dagʻi dardu hol matlub. Har kimgaki ulum boʻlsa vosil, Gar dardiyu holi yoʻq, ne hosil? (It is crusial that everyone who strives for perfection has pain in his heart. At the heart of this pain should be love, joy, compassion, righteousness.) Alisher Navoi is a constant supporter of arming young people with secular sciences. The poet emphasizes the need for a sincere approach to the acquisition of these sciences. Alisher Navoi has always glorified man and his dignity. That is why he condemns despair for man.

Ahbob, dengizki, xonu mondan tama' uz, Ne xonu mon, kavnu makondan tama' uz. Ne kavnu makon, jonu jahondan tama' uz, Lekin demangiz, meniki, Ondin tama' uz.

(That is, the great thinker says in this work, "Friends, you can tell me to despair of everything, but never despair of the Creator (Allah)." In this way, the poet urges people to adhere to moral standards. Students must the answer question posed observation. Khandamir, a contemporary of the poet, narrates the following story in his book "Makarim-ul-ahlag": After praving performing his duties, Alisher Navoi would talk to the congregation, ask about the situation, and cheer up the sick and needy. For some reason, one day they got used to leaving and hurried somewhere. When asked by a group unfamiliar with the situation. Navoi commented: "When I greeted my shoulders, I saw an ant standing over me. I knew that this ant came out of the place where I had performed ablution, and I put it in its place, thinking of the sin and burden of losing an animal from its food. "[4]

High school students will learn what causes ignorance and what the education to overcome them is. Do we always keep in mind that life is very short, and do we always try to make the most of it? We turn to the wisdom of Alisher Navoi to find solutions to the questions that call for such observation. Navoi expresses this fact so beautifully that the reader is

absolutely moved and eager to do good deeds as soon as possible:

Xazon sipohigʻa ey bogʻbon, emas mone,

Bu bogʻ tomida gar ignadin tikan qilgʻil.

That is, poet says that oh, gardener, no matter how much you look after the trees you grow in your garden, even if you cover the walls with thorns, you will not be able to stop the cavalry. In the process of explaining its meaning to our students, we identify the factors that lead to the ugly events that happen in life, and explain that a person needs knowledge and experience to avoid it.

Alisher Navoi in his epic "Hayrat ul-abror" also speaks about the duties and responsibilities of parents to their children. First of all, when a child is born, parents need to give it a proper name. Second, the teacher must be called upon to teach, and the child must be loved.

**Parents** responsible are for the upbringing of their children, and they have always done their part. From the moment a child is born, parents take care of him with love, feed him, feed him, and strive to make him knowledgeable and educated so that he can find his place in life. In short, they give all their strength and energy to their child. It is even more exemplary that such childhood is embedded in the noble reforms carried out by our state. The poet advises parents to equate service, and the more you serve, the less you serve. [5] Students are taught that it is a form of humanity to serve a self-sacrificing parent for their child, to win their hearts, and to please their hearts with sweet words and kindness.

Humanism means the struggle for the full realization of human dignity, freedom, abilities, the pursuit of human happiness, equality, justice, the creation of conditions for the emergence of all the principles of humanity. Humanism is an integral part of the national psyche of the Uzbek people. [3]

Therefore, in the educational process, the formation of human qualities in students

through creative approaches to the lesson is important for its effectiveness. For example, to lead to performances that reflect the exemplary lives and activities of great figures. It is important to travel to the shrines where they live forever, watch movies, listen to songs and music videos about them.
