Based on the above considerations, we believe that today's modern primary school teacher needs to combine the following in order to improve his / her professional skills: modern primary school teacher should have special knowledge in pedagogical and psychological and various sciences must be prepared, possess professional and personal qualities.

In addition, in our opinion, the following should be required of a primary school teacher today, namely:

- The teacher can be in the hearts of students and love them, connect their love and feelings with the inner world of students;

- have a deep understanding of the changes taking place in the social life of society, the essence of the ongoing socio-economic reforms and be able to provide students with sound information in this regard;

- be aware of the latest achievements in world science in their field, as well as innovations and achievements in science, technology and information and communication technologies, ie be able to apply advanced pedagogical practices in their work;

- in addition to the knowledge of his specialty, to establish good interdisciplinary communication and to conduct continuous research on it;

- be able to effectively use the most effective forms, methods and tools of education in the process of pedagogical activity;

- High pedagogical skills, pedagogical ability, pedagogical technique, pedagogical culture, culture of behavior, culture of speech and culture of dress;

- be able to reasonably, calmly, correctly assess any pedagogical situation and rationally eliminate conflicts that arise in the educational process;

- be able to take a creative approach to their profession;

- constantly improve their knowledge and professional skills.

Prospective primary school teachers should be able to organize the educational process, as well as the skills of organizing organizational work. They are manifested in the following: -organization of spirituality days;

- -Development of action plans for spiritual education;
- -manage the work of the class team on the school plot;
- organization of beautification works;
- be able to decorate the classroom with modern equipment;
- be able to regularly monitor cleanliness;
- be able to organize trips with students;

- be able to organize celebrations in the classroom and at school on the eve of national holidays.

Since the knowledge acquired in the primary school is the foundation for the next stage of education, a great responsibility is placed on the primary school teachers. Modern technology is an effective tool in getting them interested in the lesson quickly and easily.
