

## **PRIORITIES OF STATE YOUTH POLICY IN NEW UZBEKISTAN**

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### **1. INTRODUCTION:**

During the years of independence, the Republic of Uzbekistan has undergone radical changes in the socio-political, economic, spiritual and educational spheres, and the ongoing reforms are bearing fruit. Efforts to modernize the country and develop the economy sustainably are welcomed by the citizens of the society. Socio-cultural activity is improving, the effectiveness of work in the spiritual and ideological spheres, in the end, leads to positive changes in the thinking of the individual.

A comprehensive analysis of the content of these changes is becoming one of the most pressing issues of today. After gaining independence, our state paid special attention to youth policy. In particular, it has set itself a clear goal to develop a new youth policy. What is the main content and purpose of this policy?

This was a very important and urgent issue that needed to be addressed and urgently addressed. It was necessary to prepare our youth spiritually and spiritually for the new social relations associated with the transition to a market economy, to create the necessary conditions for them to adapt to the new economic conditions without excessive difficulties. Our country today needs intelligent entrepreneurs and business people, and they should consist mainly of young people. Economic reforms in our country are on the way to establishing the principles of social justice in our society.

During the years of independence in the Republic of Uzbekistan, the ongoing reforms in the socio-political, economic, spiritual and educational spheres have begun to bear fruit. In the new Uzbekistan, it is very important to provide broad and adequate coverage of the priorities of state youth policy and the work being done to create conditions for social protection of young people.

### **2. METHODS AND LEVEL OF STUDY:**

The study and scientific analysis of the issues of social protection in Uzbekistan belongs to almost all social sciences and humanities. This problem has recently been studied to some extent by economists, philosophers, political scientists, historians and lawyers.

M.Rasulov's fundamental book "Fundamentals of Market Economy", which is generally positive, pays special attention to the social orientation of the market economy in the conditions of independence, the problems of unemployment and their solutions, the stratification of the population. In the work of M. Kholmatova and S. Safaeva, the issue of the human factor is given priority.

### **3. RESEARCH RESULTS:**

In particular, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Miromonovich Mirziyoyev has continued this work, paying special attention to the work carried out in the

framework of state youth policy, including social protection and employment of youth.

Speaking about the positive achievements in the field of social protection under the state program for 2016, the President said, "As part of the program, about 9 million women of childbearing age and about 10 million children have undergone medical examinations and rehabilitation.

700,000 children have been vaccinated against pneumococcal infection and other infectious diseases.

Within the framework of the program, great work has been done to create the necessary conditions for our women, to build modern housing and social infrastructure in rural areas on the basis of standard projects.

At the same time, \$ 100 million has been attracted with foreign investment to provide rural areas with drinking water and modernize water networks in districts and cities." [1]

Of course, this is an example of the high attention paid to young people and their health in our country.

President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. M. Mirziyoev also touched upon the confidence of our people in the future, saying, "The large-scale reforms being carried out in our country are supported by our people. The first results of these changes are clearly reflected in the life and daily life of our people. The social activity of our people and their confidence in the future are growing." [2]

At present, 32% or 10 million of the population of our country are under 30 years old [3-B13]. Speaking about youth issues, President Mirziyoyev said, "We will resolutely pursue the state youth policy without any deviations. Not only will we continue, but we will elevate this policy to the high level required by the times today as our top priority. We will mobilize all the forces and capabilities of our state and society for the development and happiness of our young people as independent

thinkers, with high intellectual and spiritual potential, who will not be idle to their peers in any field around the world "[4-B14].

Speaking about the urgency of the work on social protection, the President said, "The most important socio-economic task is to implement the program to increase employment, approved by the chambers of the Oliy Majlis. We need to create more than a million new jobs by the end of the year.

The issue of employment of 480,000 graduates of professional colleges requires special control. [5].

The "Strategy of actions on five priority directions of development of the Republic of Uzbekistan" [6], adopted on February 7, 2017 under the direct initiative and leadership of President Shavkat Mirziyoyev, has launched a new era of development in the lives of young people.

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In order to consistently and effectively implement the state youth policy, comprehensively support the youth, radically reform the system of protection of their rights and legitimate interests, and in this regard, taking into account the suggestions and comments of the general public, especially youth: Uzbekistan "Kamolot" youth In accordance with the decision of the IV Congress of the Social Movement on June 30, 2017, the Youth Union of Uzbekistan was established and the date of formation of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan - June 30 was declared "Youth Day" in our country.

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**First**, to transform the Youth Union of Uzbekistan into a professional structure under the motto "Youth - the builder of the future", providing effective cooperation with government agencies, non-governmental organizations and other civil society institutions in the implementation of state youth policy in the country;

**Secondly**, to protect the rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of young people, to educate them in the spirit of respect for national and universal values, loyalty to the ideas of independence in their minds and hearts, understanding of national identity, love and concern for the motherland, determination and development of self-determination; thirdly, to increase the activity of young people in the reforms aimed at building a democratic state and the development of civil society, to mobilize all the efforts, knowledge and potential for the benefit of the people, high-spirited, independent-minded, strong life position, broad outlook and deep knowledge , expanding the ranks of young people who are able to take responsibility for the future of the country;

**Fourth**, to create favorable conditions for young people to master modern professions, to

provide employment, to develop entrepreneurial skills, to involve them in small business and private entrepreneurship, to encourage their initiatives, to help them realize their intellectual and creative potential;

**Fifth**, by increasing the interest of young people in reading scientific and art books, including electronic works, raising the culture of legal, environmental, medical and information and communication technologies, they will be exposed to various ideological threats, including religious extremism, terrorism, "popular culture" and others. formation of strong immunity against foreign ideas;

**Sixth**, the widespread promotion of healthy lifestyles and family sanctity among young people, the implementation of effective measures to prevent early marriage and divorce of young families;

seventh, the wide involvement of young people in sports and physical education, creative clubs and various courses, including foreign language training, in order to meaningfully organize the leisure time of their unorganized part;

**Eighth**, the organization of targeted work aimed at providing moral and material support to young families, in particular, young people with disabilities and those in need of social protection, to create decent housing and social and living conditions for them;

**Ninth**, active participation in the early prevention and prevention of delinquency and crime among young people;

**Tenth**, to educate, create a reserve of educated, enterprising, enterprising, honest and dedicated young leaders who will take an active part in the ongoing reforms in the country, who will faithfully serve the interests of the people,

and recommend them to responsible positions in state and economic administration;

**Eleventh**, further development of international cooperation in the field of youth policy, implementation of measures aimed at protecting the rights and interests of young people studying and working abroad;

**Twelfth**, to provide ideological and methodological assistance to state and economic administration bodies, non-governmental non-profit organizations and other institutions of civil society in the organization of youth activities.

To organize effective public control over the activities of the competent authorities involved in the implementation of state youth policy, to take effective measures as a result.

In 2016, about 10 million children underwent medical examinations and recovered. In particular, the Republican Specialized Scientific-Practical Medical Center of Pediatrics performed cochlear implantation operations on more than 350 children with hearing impairments. 21 billion soums were spent for this purpose. But what matters to us is not how much money is spent, but how the health of hundreds of our children is restored. [8-B13]. Speaking about the work done on youth issues in 2017, President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev said, "One of the most important results of our reforms this year is undoubtedly the complete abolition of child labor and forced labor in our country. It is noteworthy that such positive changes have been recognized by the International Labor Organization and other structures," he said. [9] Speaking about employment, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. Mirziyoyev said, "It is obvious that we have set as a priority the provision of employment, so we must pay special attention not only to quantity but also to quality." [10]

Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated July 5, 2017 "On increasing the effectiveness of state youth policy and support the activities of the Youth Union of Uzbekistan" In accordance with the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated September 23, 2017 753 Resolution "On additional measures to support young families who are actively involved in the social life of the country in providing them with housing" was signed. Each year has its own perfectly developed Program, in which the care of the state is reflected. Only in 2017, our President Sh. One of the most commendable things done under the leadership of Mirziyoyev is the development and implementation of a new mechanism to provide our people with the cheapest and most affordable housing. President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh. Speaking about this, Mirziyoyev said, "It is worth noting that for the first time in the last 25 years, we have begun to build affordable, multi-storey housing for the population. In 2017 alone, more than 800,000 square meters of such facilities were commissioned. "[11] In particular, it should be noted that over the past five years in Surkhandarya region on the basis of standard projects built about 5,800 settlements in 178 areas [12-B182]. Based on the above, it should be noted that at the heart of such noble deeds is, first of all, the interests of man and the goal of ensuring his happy life. Touching upon the positive work to be done in 2020, the President said, "In 2020, 5.5 thousand women will be provided with soft loans worth 100 billion soums for small business projects. To do this, I allocate resources to banks from the state budget In addition, 1,576 women will receive an initial payment from the budget to acquire new housing.

The training of our sisters in need of social protection in Women's Entrepreneurship Centers will be organized in short training courses within the framework of 5 important

initiatives" [13]. A video conference was held on July 8, 2020 under the chairmanship of Shavkat Mirziyoyev. The meeting focused on the work being done to reduce poverty. The head of state noted the need to "employ at least 257,000 needy families, provide loans to 37,000 households in the framework of family business." In 2021, large-scale work on comprehensive social protection and poverty reduction will be continued.

On August 31, 2021, at the ceremony dedicated to the 30th anniversary of state independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev in his report "Independence of our country is a source of strength and inspiration for us, the basis of development and prosperity" adopted the National Human Rights Strategy. Compulsory and child labor, which has been a serious problem for many years, has been completely abolished. . Now the coverage of graduates with higher education has increased from 9% in 2016 to 28%. It is planned to increase this figure to 50-60% in the near future.

Supporting the population in need of social protection, especially young people, is in the center of our constant attention. For this purpose, this year 3,155 additional quotas have been allocated for young people with disabilities, 1,580 for graduates of orphanages and orphanages, and 2,000 for women from low-income families as state grants.

At the ceremony, the President said: "We all need to understand one thing: such priorities that we have set for ourselves are very complex and truly great.

At the same time, over time, the world is changing, and the demands of our people for a better life are growing. Now we cannot please our people with yesterday's result. Today, every day requires research and innovation. Only by working on the basis of such requirements can the life of our people be changed for the better."

#### 4. CONCLUSIONS:

In conclusion, it should be noted that since the presidency of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev, the priorities of state youth policy in the new Uzbekistan have risen to a new level. Enough

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
