In the teaching of words, teachers can determine the content of the text, and to attract the attention of the students, the educator can draw their picture on the board by pronouncing the words together with them.

Therefore, the tutor is now required to have drawing skills. This not only reduces the difficulty of teaching, but also helps students to gradually consolidate the knowledge they have learned. In order for the students to feel the progress in the process of learning English, it is necessary to have a perfect approach to each educational activity. Therefore, the teacher should provide songs that the children like to listen to, poems or quick sayings to practice the language, or if not, an animated cartoon that the children like.

> Reasons why the educator is not able to achieve the desired results.

When we worked with children, we found out that children's intuitive learning is much higher than ours, that is, that of adults. - ✓ By removing the barriers between the student and the teacher, the student can find a way to the heart of the children. They will need to start questioning with a sense of politeness.
- ✓ All educators should be able to ask questions based on the child's psychology, which requires him to prepare questions based on the child's language level. No matter how we teach preschoolers, we can still see some differences in language among children, and their level of receptivity will vary.
- ✓ Asking more about the previous topics will increase the excitement in the child, until the skill of the new topic is formed, the excitement about the new topic will remain, at least a little, and the educator should take a strong approach to overcome this.

At this point, we will summarize our topic and give some recommendations.

- In China, new mass multimedia tools are widely used in the field of education. Today, as educational tools, Internet and multimedia technologies are effectively used in kindergartens, bringing new skills to the education of young children. It is necessary to give them a constant cartoon lesson in foreign languages, the development of the child's foreign language skills from the kindergarten age will help him to easily accept all knowledge at the next stage.
- The development of language skills at the kindergarten stage is mainly formed through constant imitation, and many roles often appear in cartoons through imitation. Therefore, when watching a cartoon, we can see the changes in children's actions. Therefore, we can use the cartoon as an effective educational tool, which can help improve children's learning performance. Nowadays, some parents are very concerned about children's interest in cartoons, but in fact, in the development of young children, their fantasy serves as the main factor in the formation of their worldview.
