The causes of suicide are very complex. The reasons may be biological, genetic, psychological and social aspects of teenager. Nevertheless, Teens commit suicide in extreme situations as a result of public discrimination, learning problems, and betrayal. Many experts think this is an excuse then cause for suicide.

There are various causes of suicide in Teens: conflicts in private life; loneliness; skillful exposure; irresponsible feelings; non-standard adaptation; violation of ethnic traditions; heredity suicide.

According to the inclined to commit sutsididial behavior we can see following conflicting groups: Teens who have previously committed suicide (incomplete, parasuicide). Teens who expose suicide threats openly or covertly. Teens who are inclined to self-harm (autoaggression). Teens with heredity suicide descendants. Teens under alcohol influence. The risk of suicide is very high in such type of Teens. The level is 50% among young people. Prolonged alcohol intake serves chronic alcohol consumption of several generations, as well as contributes to the intensification of depression and guilt and mental illness leading to suicide. Teens, dolescent chronic drug and toxic use. Consumption of PAS (psycho-active substances) weakens the teen's self-control and even causes mental illness. Teens suffering from neurological disorders, especially teens under severe depression (psychopathological syndromes). Teens suffering from chronic or congenital diseases (also adults suffering from these diseases). Teens who are grieving over major losses, such as the death of a parent (loved one), especially the first years of loss, and so on. Teens brought up in troubled families: divorce at a certain age, divorce, domestic violence, etc. The most important factor influencing suicidal behavior is religion. Suicide is much less common in people of faith than in non-believers. In summary, we highlight the characteristics of teens:

- 1. Teens do not have a clear idea of death. An adult understands that death is the end of life, while a teenager does not fully understand it. For them, it is a virtual game to some extent.
- 2. The 3 most important environments for a teenager are: family, school, peers.
- 3. The cause of a teen's suicide may be trivial, even accidental, at first.
- 4. Teenagers-specific subcultures may influence the formation of suicidal behavior in teens.
- 5. Teens may not have a suicidal idea and attempt phase.
- 6. A teenager cannot explain what is happening to him, his whole situation, or his problems.
- 7. It is often scary to live in that reality than to die for a teenager,.
- 8. Teens` suicide is often characterized by a call for help, self-attention, or trying to solve their problems as adult way.

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It is important to know and take into account the age and psychological characteristics of teens. They also need to have self-confidence, identify optimal parenting strategies, encourage students to succeed in family and school tasks, give children the opportunity to choose independent activities (reading, play, work, hobbies and interests), and teach children their own behavior. it is necessary to form an assessment teaching.
